THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT – DAYS 1-10

August 5 – Teshuvah Preparatory Service

REPENT FOR:

- Day 1 August 6 – Failure to walk in the fruit of *love*
- Day 2 August 7 – Failure to walk in *joy* in the Holy Spirit
- Day 3 August 8 – Failure to have *peace* that transcends all understanding

TESHUVAH 2013 THEME: THE HOLY SPIRIT 40-DAY TESHUVAH PRAYER & REPENTANCE FORMAT

Each of the 40 days of Teshuvah will have a prayer/repentance focus and key scripture verse(s).

As we open with prayer and worship, allow the Spirit to minister to you as you worship the King of Kings and Lord of Lords.

This leads to a time of *personal*, silent reflection and repentance before the Lord.

We continue with a time of prayer and intercession for our *families*. At this time, prayer is silent or “Korean style”. Korean style prayer is a commonly used method in Korea where a group of people prays out loud simultaneously. God hears every prayer given at every moment from a limitless number of people.

Our next prayer/repentance focus is for our *nation*. It is critical in this hour to lift up our nation’s leaders, politicians and judges and to repent for our nation’s ongoing move away from its Christian foundation and our nation’s ongoing move toward sin and darkness.

We move into our next prayer/repentance focus, which is *Israel*. This is a time for Gentile believers to repent for the horrific things that have been said and done to the Jewish people throughout Church history in the name of Christianity. Our focus this Teshuvah will be acts and words of contemporary Anti-Semitism. It is also a time to pray for Israel’s leaders and for the Israeli people in this very dangerous and threatening time for the Jewish people. We endorse God’s will to “pray for the peace of Jerusalem” and that “all Israel will be saved.”

Finally, we intercede and repent for the *Church*. The Messiah is returning for a holy and blameless Bride without spot, wrinkle or blemish (Eph. 5:27). We repent and intercede for the Church in order to “***make ready for the Lord a people prepared.***” (Luke 1:17)

Our daily Teshuvah closes with praise and thanksgiving to our Lord and King, the Holy One of Israel.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO WALK IN
THE FRUIT OF LOVE
TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2013
DAY 1**

*But the fruit of the Spirit is **love**, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23*

My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. John 15:13-14

*And now these three remain: faith, hope and **love**. But the greatest of these is **love**—1Cor 13:13*

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Matthew 22:36-40

WORSHIP: Musical selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Cor 13:8-13

Does my life reflect the love of Christ?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families. Read Eph 3:14-19

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family members when we do not reflect the love of Christ.

Intercede: For a greater measure of the fruit of LOVE.

NATION: 1 Timothy 2:1-5

Thank our Father for the outpouring of love our nation has shown to the world in times of great need.

Repent: That our nation does not reflect Matthew 22:36-40

Intercede: That a powerful outpouring of the Spirit will move the nation back to our God and King.

ISRAEL: *But the land you are crossing the Jordan to take possession of is a land of mountains and valleys that drinks rain from heaven. It is a land the Lord your God cares for; for the eyes of the Lord your God are continually on it from the beginning of the year to its end.* Deut 11:11-12

Thank our Father for loving and never taking His eyes off Israel.

Repent: Apathy toward Israel; and not loving and caring for what God does.

Intercede: Our hearts would soften and we would love Israel as God does.

Anti-Semitism: America has started transferring advanced weaponry, including F-16 fighter jets and 200 sophisticated Abrams tanks to the Muslim-Brotherhood controlled Egyptian regime—at a time when Egypt’s leaders are threatening to go to war with Israel. (From ZOA, Zionist Organization of America)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism .

CHURCH: *All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. Every day they continued to meet in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.* Acts 2:44-47

Thank our Father for the unity of the early believers. As they walked in the fruit of love, many were saved.

Repent: For failure to walk in the love that would draw people to the Messiah.

Intercede: For the love of God to be shed abroad in our hearts. (Romans 5:5)

PRAISE/THANK Our Father, Who so *loved* us that He gave His only Son to die as an atoning sacrifice for our sins

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO WALK IN
JOY IN THE HOLY SPIRIT
WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 7, 2013
DAY 2**

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23

For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and approved by men. Rom 14:17-18

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Psalm 16:5-11

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Romans 14:17-18

Joy is not a fleeting emotion, and our position IN CHRIST is our joy.

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family members who do not walk in the fruit of joy.

Intercede: Revelation that the joy of the Lord is my strength (Neh 8:10)

NATION: *You have multiplied the nation and increased its joy. Isa 9:3a*

Thank our Father for the joy & blessing you have bestowed upon our nation.

Repent: That our nation continues to turn away from You, which results in losing Your blessing and losing our joy.

Intercede: That our nation will return to You and that our joy and blessing will be a powerful witness to the world.

ISRAEL: *There was great joy in Jerusalem, for since the days of Solomon son of David king of Israel there had been nothing like this in Jerusalem. 2Ch30:26*

Thank our Father that He will establish and make Jerusalem a praise in the earth. (Isaiah 62:7)

Repent: That the world pressures Israel to give up half her capitol, Jerusalem, which has been covenanted to Israel by God.

Intercede: Pray that God would pour out His Spirit and restore great joy in Jerusalem.

Anti-Semitism: America's most powerful cabinet posts are being filled with nominees who support anti-Israel policies and have expressed blatant anti-Semitic views about American Jews (from ZOA, Zionist Organization of America).

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *So being sent on their way by the church, they passed through Phoenicia and Samaria, describing the conversion of the Gentiles; and they caused great joy to all the brethren. Acts 15:3*

Thank our Father that the early church brought great joy to the brethren.

Repent: That joy is often absent in today's church.

Intercede: That a powerful move of the Spirit will restore a joy to the church that will encourage the brethren and bring many to salvation.

PRAISE/THANK OUR FATHER for giving us the fruit of joy by His Spirit. Thank you, Father, that YOUR joy is OUR strength.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO HAVE THE PEACE
THAT TRANSCENDS ALL UNDERSTANDING
THURSDAY, AUGUST 8, 2013
DAY 3**

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, **peace**, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23*

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Phil 4:6-7

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Isaiah 9:6-7

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Phil 4:4-9

The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything. Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members who struggle with anxiety, which is counter-productive and opposed to God's peace.

Intercede: For the inner tranquility that comes from committing all our cares to God in prayer.

NATION: *If you follow my decrees and are careful to obey my commands, I will grant peace in the land and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid. I will remove savage beasts from the land, and the sword will not pass through your country. Lev 26:3, 6*

Thank our Father that for over a century our nation has had peace within its borders.

Repent: Our nation is not obeying God's decrees and commands as abortion is legal, and many states have legalized homosexual marriage.

Intercede: A Spirit of repentance will fall on our nation, and it will turn back to God's decrees and continue to enjoy peace within our borders.

ISRAEL: *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: May those who love you be secure. May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels.*

Psalm 122:6-7

Thank our Father that the Prince of Peace will rule and reign in Jerusalem at the end of the age.

Repent: For pressure on Israel to give up land in order to have peace.

Intercede: Peace and security within Israel's borders.

Anti-Semitism: In November, 2011, Hamas launched over 1600 rockets into Israel. Despite this, 14 member of the EU voted to elevate the Palestinian Authority to the status of non-member state.

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *Finally, brothers, good-bye. Aim for perfection, listen to my appeal, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you.*

2Cor 13:11

Thank our Father that as we live in peace, being of one mind, the God of love and peace will be with us.

Repent: The church denominations are divided as they focus on differences.

Intercede: The church denominations will be of one mind, focusing on the pre-eminence of Christ and will live in peace with one another.

PRAISE/THANK OUR FATHER that through prayer, petition and thanksgiving, the peace of God, which transcends all understanding will guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO WALK IN
THE FRUIT OF PATIENCE
FRIDAY, AUGUST 9, 2013
DAY 4**

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, **patience**, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23*

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing. James 1:2-4

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Psalm 40:1-5

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read James 1:2-4

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members who lack the fruit of patience.

Intercede: Patience with difficult people and circumstances (Rom 12:12-13)

NATION: *The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in mercy. Psalm 103:8*

Thank our Father for He is patient, merciful and long-suffering with our nation.

Repent: Our nation is moving more into darkness and away from the light as we turn away from God.

So rend your heart, not your garments; Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm. Joel 2:13

Intercede: The Lord will pour out a spirit of repentance upon the *heart* of our nation and we will return to Him.

ISRAEL: Read Leviticus 26:43-45

Thank our Father for His patience with His covenantal people.

Repent: For impatience toward the Jewish people as they continue in unbelief.

Intercede: That all Israel will be saved.

And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: “The Deliverer will come out of Zion, and He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; for this is My covenant with them, when I take away their sins.” Romans 11:26-27

Anti-Semitism: Since 2009, the levels of anti-Semitic attitudes throughout Europe have increased by upwards of 70% in countries like Hungary and the UK. This percentage is higher than it has been since WWII. (From Jewish Voice Today, April, 2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *To the angel at the church of Ephesus write... you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name’s sake and have not become weary.* Rev 2:1a, 3

Thank our Father for His patience and long-suffering with the church.

Repent: *Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest, and repent.* Rev 3:19

The Church is not focused on repentance and does not embrace that repentance precedes the return of the Messiah.

Intercede: A spirit of repentance to fall on the church to prepare the way of the Lord.

PRAISE/THANK Our Father for His patience, loving kindness and mercies that are new every morning.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO WALK IN
THE FRUIT OF KINDNESS
SATURDAY, AUGUST 10, 2013
DAY 5**

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, **kindness**, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23*

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. Eph 4:32

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Luke 6:35

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Ephesians 4:32

Ask the Spirit to highlight those to whom you have not been kind and tenderhearted.

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and our family members that we expect the Lord to deal kindly with us and yet we do not deal kindly with each other.

Intercede: That the Spirit will fill us with the fruit of kindness that would draw the lost and hurting straight to the heart of God.

NATION: *Blessed be the Lord, for He has shown me His marvelous kindness in a strong city!* Psalm 31:21

Thank our Father that in His kindness, He has poured out abundant blessing upon our nation.

Repent: Due to pride and arrogance, many in our nation do not give God praise and glory for His loving kindness and abundant blessing.

Intercede: That the Spirit would move upon our nation and move hearts to gratitude and to realize that our all our blessings are because of God’s kindness.

ISRAEL: *So too, at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace.*

Romans 11:5

Thank our Father that in His kindness He has reserved a faithful remnant within Israel, chosen by grace.

Repent: On behalf of the vast majority of Jewish people who persist in unbelief.

Intercede: That the Spirit would cleanse Israel from all her impurities and give her a new heart. *I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.* Ezekiel 36:25-26

Anti-Semitism: Brooklyn College recently hosted a “forum” whose purpose was to encourage the “Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions” against Israel. Israel was accused of being “an outlaw regime that routinely violates human rights.”

(From B’nai Brith International)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Thank our Father for those in His church who understand that He covenanted the land to Israel *eternally*.

Repent: For those church denominations that support the boycott, divestment and sanctions against Israel and accuse Israel of being an outlaw regime.

Intercede: That the Spirit would move on the hearts of church leaders to understand God’s heart and plan for Israel and the Jewish people.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that His loving kindness endures forever.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO ABIDE IN THE VINE
THAT BEARS THE FRUIT OF GOODNESS
SUNDAY, AUGUST 11, 2013
DAY 6**

*But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, **goodness**, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23*

I am the true vine and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. Remain in me and I will remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. John 15:1-4

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Psalm 34

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read John 15:1-4

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and our family members who do not abide in the vine that produces the fruit of goodness.

Intercede: We would welcome the Father's pruning so that we will be even more fruitful.

NATION: *Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. Psalm 23:6*

Thank our Father for the goodness our nation shows throughout the world in times of great need.

Repent: Our nation takes for granted the goodness and love of the Lord.

Intercede: Our Father will continue to shine His goodness & love upon us.

ISRAEL: *The whole land of Canaan, where you are now an alien, I will give as an everlasting possession to you and your descendants after you and I will be their God.* Genesis 17:8

Thank our Father that in His goodness He gave the land He loves to Israel in an eternal covenant.

Repent: Many of our nation's leaders and many of Israel's leaders are willing to give up God's covenantal land in the hope of a peace that will never come.

Intercede: God will raise up leaders in our nation and in Israel who understand covenant. Intercede that **all** the land God covenanted to Israel will be back in Israel's possession.

Anti-Semitism: Egyptian President Mohammed Morsi stated in a public speech: "Dear brothers, we must not forget to nurse our children and grandchildren on hatred towards those Zionists and Jews, and all those who support them. They must be nursed on hatred. The hatred must continue." (from ZOA, Zionist Organization of America)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *Make a tree good and its fruit will be good, or make a tree bad and its fruit will be bad, for a tree is recognized by its fruit... The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him.* Matt 12:33,35

Thank our Father for the goodness of the Church over the centuries to spread the gospel to the ends of the earth.

Repent: The church does not teach that the great commission was given first to Jewish men, and that salvation is through faith in the **Jewish Messiah**.

Intercede: The Spirit would awaken the church to revelation that the gospel is to the Jew first. (Romans 1:16)

PRAISE/THANK our Father for the goodness He bestows upon us.

REPENT FOR THE LACK OF FAITHFULNESS

MONDAY, AUGUST 12, 2013

DAY 7

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control Gal 5:22-23

Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. Lam 3:22-23

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Psalm 89:1-8

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Matt 25:14-21

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Above all, my brothers, do not swear—not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Let your “Yes” be yes, and your “No,” no, or you will be condemned.

James 5:12

Repent: For unfaithfulness in our words and/or actions

Intercede: For the conviction of the Holy Spirit to move us to walk in the fruit of faithfulness.

NATION: *Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; He is the faithful God, keeping His covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love Him and keep His commands. Deut 7:9*

Thank our Father for His faithfulness to our nation.

Repent: Our nation has rejected Your commands. You are so faithful, yet we are so unfaithful.

Return, faithless people; I will cure you of backsliding. Yes, we will come to you, for you are the Lord our God. Jeremiah 3:22

Intercede: Our nation will return to God and see His faithfulness.

ISRAEL: *Remember these things, O Jacob, for you are my servant, O Israel. I have made you, you are my servant; O Israel, I will not forget you. I have swept away your offenses like a cloud, your sins like the morning mist. Return to Me, for I have redeemed you. Isa 44:21-22*

Thank our Father that despite Israel's sin and disobedience, He will never forget His covenant with them.

Repent: Failure to understand that God's faithfulness to us is eternally linked to His faithfulness to Israel

Intercede: Israel would see the faithfulness of their God and repent.

Anti-Semitism: Egyptian Pres. Morsi referred to Israel during a TV interview as: "These occupiers of the land of Palestine...these blood-suckers, who attack the Palestinians, these warmongers, the descendants of apes & pigs...we should employ all forms of resistance against them. There should be military resistance within the land of Palestine against those criminal Zionists." Despite Morsi's words, the US continues to send sophisticated weapons and aircraft to Egypt.

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Thank our Father for all the faithful saints throughout the centuries.

Repent: For those who do not believe in the inerrancy of Scripture.

Intercede: That all who call themselves Christians will be faithful to love and obey God's word and keep His commands.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that because of Your great love we are not consumed, for Your compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO BE GENTLE
(FAIR, EQUITABLE, SWEETLY REASONABLE)
TUESDAY, AUGUST 13, 2013
DAY 8**

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Repent: For times when the church appears harsh and judgmental to the world.

Intercede: That the Spirit would pour out greater revelation of the true nature of gentleness upon the Body of Christ.

PRAISE/THANK Our Father who is our gentle Shepherd.

CHURCH: *But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God—having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them.* 2Tim 3:5

Thank our Father that Messiah is coming back for a pure Bride

Repent: For the ways the church compromises with the world system.

Intercede: The Spirit of wisdom which is pure, peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere would fall upon the Body of Christ.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that You grant wisdom to all who ask.

**REPENT FOR LACK OF KNOWLEDGE THAT IN CHRIST
I AM ONE NEW MAN
SATURDAY, AUGUST 17, 2013
DAY 12**

His purpose was to create in Himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace, and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which He put to death their hostility. Eph 2:15b-16

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Ephesians 2:11-22

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: In Christ I am a fellow citizen with God's people and part of the Commonwealth of Israel.

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members for the lack of knowledge and understanding of the fullness of "one new man."

If you do, consider this: You do not support the root, but the root supports you. Rom 11:17-18

Repent: For arrogance and lack of knowledge that we have been grafted into and *share* what has been given to Israel.

*This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs **together** with Israel, members **together** of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.* Ephesians 3:6

Intercede: The church would understand its position as co-heirs with Israel.

PRAISE/THANK our Father for the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God!

Repent: Wherever weak faith in the church limits God.

Intercede: That the Body of Christ will have the kind of faith to move mountains, and that the world will see the power of a faith-filled church.

CHURCH: **Thank our Father** that He has given us by His Spirit the gift of healing by faith and in the name of Jesus.

Repent: Our nation is ignoring the warnings of its prophets.

But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet to warn the people and the sword comes and takes the life of one of them, that man will be taken away because of his sin, but I will hold the watchman accountable for his blood. Ezekiel 33:6

Intercede: That prophets will fear the Lord and boldly prophesy so that they will not be held accountable.

ISRAEL: *Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?” And I said, “Here am I. Send me!” He said, “Go and tell this people: “Be ever hearing but never understanding; be ever seeing but never perceiving.’ Make the heart of this people calloused; make their ears dull and close their eyes. Isaiah 6:8-10a*

What then? What Israel sought so earnestly it did not obtain but the elect did. The others were hardened, as it is written: “God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes so that they could not see and ears so that they could not hear, to this very day.” Romans 11:7-8

Repent: For impatience with the Jewish people’s blindness and for not understanding that it is *God* who has blinded them.

Thank our Father that according to His word (Ezek 36:24-28), He will put His Spirit in Israel in the last days and they will return to Him and be saved.

Intercede: Pray Ezekiel 36:24-28 over the Jewish people.

Anti-Semitism: During the 2012 UN General Assembly session, the UN adopted 26 country-specific resolutions: **22** separate resolutions condemning Israel, and **4** for the rest of the world combined! (Iran, Syria, Burma, N. Korea.)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: Thank our Father for those churches that encourage prophecy.

Repent: That most churches fear or discourage prophetic words.

Intercede: The church at large would begin to eagerly desire prophetic words for the encouragement and edification of the body.

PRAISE/THANK our Father for His faithfulness to His word and that He speaks through His prophets today.

**REPENT FOR MY LACK OF UNDERSTANDING OF
DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN SPIRITS
THURSDAY, AUGUST 22, 2013
DAY 17**

*There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another **distinguishing between spirits**, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues 1Cor 12:4, 8-10*

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read 2 Corinthians 11:13-15

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE:

I need discernment of the spiritual war being waged between holy, human and demonic forces.

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and our families we repent of our inability to discern the major conflict being waged between God and His angels, and Satan and his demons.

Intercede: The Holy Spirit will abundantly give us the gift of spiritual discernment which comes from knowledge of the scriptures, spiritual maturity and sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.

NATION: Thank our Father that in our nation we have leaders who love you and stand for your truth.

Repent: For lying and deceiving spirits that operate through many of our leaders.

Intercede: That many more of our leaders will walk in the gift of discerning between spirits and will lead our nation in truth.

ISRAEL: *I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night.* Isaiah 62:6a

Thank our Father that He has posted watchmen on the walls of Jerusalem.

Repent: For the false teaching of Replacement Theology (Supercessionism, Fulfillment Theology, 2 Covenant Theology, Additive Theology), which is driven by demonic spirits of deception and anti-Semitism.

Intercede: The Holy Spirit would abundantly pour out the gift of distinguishing between spirits to believers in Israel, so that they can be watchmen on the walls who are acutely sensitive to demonic activity.

Anti-Semitism: On November 29, 2012, the UN General Assembly voted **139-9** in favor of recognizing Palestine within the 1967 borders as a non-member state with observer status in the UN organization. Forty-one nations abstained.

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: Thank our Father for watchmen with the gift of distinguishing between spirits who can, by supernatural insight, identify what is not truth.

Dear friends, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

1 John 4:1

Repent: For the inability to discern the spirits so that false prophets, false teachers and demonic activity infiltrate the church.

Intercede: That the Father would raise up men and women with acute sensitivity and awareness of what is going on in the spiritual realm.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that the battle is not ours, but Yours.

**REPENT FOR IMPROPER USE OF
THE GIFT OF TONGUES
FRIDAY, AUGUST 23, 2013
DAY 18**

What shall we say then brothers? When you come together, everyone has a hymn, or a word of instruction, a revelation, a tongue or an interpretation. All of these must be done for the strengthening of the church. If anyone speaks in a tongue, two—or at the most three—should speak, one at a time and someone must interpret. If there is no interpreter, the speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and God. 1 Corinthians 14:26-28

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read 1 Corinthians 14:6-14

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Cor 14:26-28

In a corporate setting, am I obedient to 1 Corinthians 14:26-28? Do I pray aloud in tongues without interpretation? Am I using my gifts to edify the church?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For improper use of tongues in a corporate setting that can cause offense and division.

Intercede: For myself and my family members that we would strive to excel in gifts that build up the church (1 Corinthians 14:12)

NATION: *What has happened to us is a result of our evil deeds and our great guilt, and yet, our God, you have punished us less than our sins have deserved and have given us a remnant like this. Ezra 9:13*

Thank our Father for the righteous remnant in our nation

Repent: We have so few leaders who boldly stand for God's truth.

Intercede: For many strong, bold leaders filled with the Holy Spirit to rise up in our nation.

ISRAEL: *When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.*

Acts 2:1-4

Thank our Father for Shavuot (Pentecost) when the first Jewish believers were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in tongues.

Repent: For forgetting that the Jewish Messiah sent the Holy Spirit first to Jewish believers who were then given the Great Commission.

Intercede: For another Pentecost, like the first, to fall on Israel and fill the Jewish people with the Holy Spirit.

Anti-Semitism: In her 12/6/12 blog post, British journalist Melanie Phillips wrote, “The de-legitimization campaign against Israel, comprising the obsessional lies and blood libels promulgated by the media and intelligentsia week in, week out, has produced this result: Jewish students in Britain are being forced to abandon their university courses out of fear.”

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.* Ephesians 4:3

Repent: For speaking in tongues chaotically and unbiblically, causing offense and division.

Intercede: That the spiritual gift of interpretation of tongues will pour out abundantly upon the body of Christ.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He is not a God of confusion, but of peace.

**REPENT FOR COVETING
THE SPIRITUAL GIFTS OF OTHERS
SATURDAY, AUGUST 24, 2013
DAY 19**

Now the body is not made up of one part but of many. 1Cor 12:14

But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as He wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body. 1Cor 12:18-20

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-20

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Cor 12:14 and 1Cor 12:18-20

Do I understand that the gifts I've been given are evidence of the Spirit working in my life? Do I appreciate and walk in the gifts given to me by the Spirit?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For lack of understanding that each of us is an important part of the body. Forgive us for desiring the gifts of others.

Intercede: For ourselves and our family members that we would joyfully embrace and walk in our individual gifts so that the body functions at its full potential.

NATION: Thank our Father for all He has blessed us with.

Repent: Our nation is taking what were once beautiful blessings from God and turning them into an abomination before the Lord.

This is what the Lord says: “Heaven is my throne and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for Me? Where will my resting place be? Has not my hand made all these things and so they came into being?” declares the Lord. Isaiah 66:1-2

Intercede: Our nation will repent and realize that all we have comes from Him.

ISRAEL: *The people of Israel. Theirs is the adoption as sons; theirs the divine glory, the covenants, the receiving of the law, the temple worship and the promises. Theirs are the Patriarchs and from them is traced the human ancestry of Christ, who is God over all, forever praised! Amen. Rom 9:4-5*

Repent: For envy and lack of gratitude for the gifts that have been given to the Jewish people.

Intercede: That gratitude and respect would replace anti-Semitism.

Anti-Semitism: In 2003, Israel sought a UN resolution, the first it had introduced since 1976. It asked for protection of Israeli children from terrorism. The resolution didn't even receive enough support to be put to a vote. (Hal Lindsey article From Jewish Voice Today, March/April, 2012)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice. James 3:16*

Repent: For envy and selfish ambition wherever it exists.

Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to Himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. Ephesians 5:25b-27

Intercede: For a single-minded and unselfish desire to present to Christ a holy and blameless bride, without stain, wrinkle or blemish.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that the Messiah will return to a holy and blameless bride, without stain, wrinkle or blemish.

**REPENT FOR BELIEVING THAT MY GIFTS
ARE SUPERIOR TO OTHERS' GIFTS
SUNDAY, AUGUST 25, 2013
DAY 20**

Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

1Cor 12:7

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read 1 Corinthians 12:21-26

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Cor 12:7

Do I understand that all the gifts are interdependent and necessary for the body to function?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members for believing that our gifts are superior to others' gifts.

Intercede: That we would walk in humility, not promoting our own gifts, but concerned only with the proper function of the body.

NATION: Thank our Father that in our nation we have the freedom to develop our God-given gifts to their full potential.

Repent: For those leaders who use their gifts not for the good of the nation, but for individual gain and self-promotion.

Intercede: For a realization that all gifts are God-given and that a spirit of humility and fear of the Lord will fall on our nation.

ISRAEL: *Through your offspring all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me.* Genesis 22:18

Thank our Father that because of Abraham’s faith and obedience, all nations have been blessed through his offspring.

Repent: Lack of understanding of *why* God “chose” the Jewish people and *what* He chose them for—to bless all the nations.

For God does not show favoritism. Romans 2:11

Intercede: For the church to understand that in Messiah, we have been grafted into and *share* the blessings given to Israel. There are no favorites with God.

Anti-Semitism: Israel is the **only** nation to become a permanent part of the U.N. Human Rights Council’s agenda. Israel has been the target of more condemnatory resolutions than all the rest of the nations combined. (Hal Lindsey article From Jewish Voice Today, March/April, 2012)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Repent: Wherever arrogance and self-promotion exist within the church.

Intercede: That church leaders would walk humbly, unselfishly, and with the complete understanding of their crucial role in promoting the health of the body.

PRAISE/THANK our Father: How beautiful is the body of Christ.

**REPENT FOR THE TRADITIONS OF MAN
THAT QUENCH THE HOLY SPIRIT
MONDAY, AUGUST 26, 2013
DAY 21**

Do not put out the Spirit's fire; do not treat prophecies with contempt. Test everything. Hold on to the good. Avoid every kind of evil. 1Thess 5:19-20

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Mark 7:6-13

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Thess 5:19-20

Are there traditions I hold onto that quench (put out the fire of) the Holy Spirit in me? What traditions do I hold onto out of a man-pleasing spirit?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For all the vain traditions of man that we hold on to.

Intercede: That the Spirit will reveal those vain traditions of man in your life and the lives of family members that quench the power of the Holy Spirit.

NATION: Thank our Father for the traditions in our nation that have brought honor to Him.

Repent: That rejection and outlawing of prayer is increasing in many venues in our nation.

Intercede: That the growing rejection of all things Christian in our nation will cease and that our nation will turn back to God with a humble and contrite spirit.

ISRAEL: Thank our Father that after 3400 years, the Jewish people continue to walk out the feasts and festivals, which point to and are fulfilled in the Messiah.

For Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed. Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with the old yeast, the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth. 1Cor 5:7b-8

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people, that they observe the feasts and festivals out of tradition and without eyes to see their complete purpose and fulfillment.

Intercede: That the Spirit will open the eyes of Jewish people and they will see the beautiful fulfillment in Messiah of all their feasts and festivals.

Anti-Semitism: A new form of anti-Semitism has arisen (called Anti-Zionism) and the people of the new anti-Semitism actually state that they are against anti-Semitism and accept Jews as people of equal human worth. However, their anti-Israel stand betrays an anti-Semitic spiritual reality of which they may not even be aware. (From Daniel Juster, Jewish Voice Today, March/April 2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it. I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers. Galatians 1:13-14*

Repent: For times when the church is more zealous for its traditions than for the power of the Holy Spirit.

Intercede: That the Spirit of wisdom and revelation will overtake the church to reveal and remove the empty traditions that quench the Spirit's fire.

PRAISE/THANK our Father for His word, that gives us instruction and wisdom.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO BE LED
BY THE HOLY SPIRIT
TUESDAY, AUGUST 27, 2013
DAY 22**

For all those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. Rom 8:14

For those who live according to the flesh have their outlook shaped by the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit have their outlook shaped by the things of the Spirit. Romans 8:5

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Romans 8:2-8

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Romans 8:14

Do I walk by the flesh or by the Spirit?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members, when we walk according to the flesh and not by the leading of the Holy Spirit.

Intercede: That we would be sensitive and obey the promptings of the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us in all things.

NATION: *And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever—the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. But you know Him, for He lives with you and will be in you. John 14:16-17b*

Thank our Father for those in our nation who are led by the Holy Spirit of God.

Repent: For our leaders who walk in the ways of the world and not by the Holy Spirit.

Intercede: That our nation, which is moving closer to a one-world system, would turn back to God in true repentance.

ISRAEL: Thank our Father for all those who have been led by your Spirit to pray and intercede on behalf of Israel and the Jewish people.

But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. Gal 5:18

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people who continue to put themselves under the law.

Intercede: By the power of the Holy Spirit, the Jewish people would be led into all truth.

Human rights abuses in the Muslim world cause the death of tens of thousands; the oppression of women is enormous. Yet Israel's injustices are much more emphasized than the greatest human rights abuses in the world. Israel is the only real democracy in the Middle East, with freedom of speech, real freedom of religion, and women's rights. Yet Israel is much more vilified. (From Daniel Juster, Jewish Voice Today, March/April 2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power. 1Cor 2:4-5*

Thank our Father for those churches who are led by the Spirit's power and wisdom.

Repent: For church leaders that quench the Spirit by leading their congregations in their own strength and wisdom, and not by the Holy Spirit.

PRAISE/THANK our Father because He has given us a Counselor and Advocate who leads us in all wisdom and truth.

REPENT FOR FAILURE TO BE A LIGHT TO THE WORLD
WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 28, 2013
DAY 23

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. And God said, "Let there be light, and there was light." God saw that the light was good, and He separated the light from the darkness. Genesis 1:1-4

You are the light of the world. Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven. Matt 5:14, 16

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read 2 Corinthians 2:4-7

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Matt 5:14, 16

How brightly does *my* light shine?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: **Thank our Father** for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and family members when we quench the light that is in us by walking in sin and disobedience.

Intercede: That our light will shine brightly before men that they may see our good deeds and praise our Father in heaven.

NATION: *This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. But whomever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God. John 3:19-21*

Repent: For those in our nation who love darkness and hide their evil deeds.

Intercede: That light will expose the evil deeds of men and that our nation would be filled with the light.

ISRAEL: *I, the Lord, have called you in righteousness, I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles.* Isaiah 4:6

Thank our Father for calling Israel to reflect His light to the Gentiles.

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people that they are not currently walking in the full calling to be a light to the Gentiles.

Intercede: For Gentile believers to be a light to the Jewish people.

Anti-Semitism: Anti-Semitism has become acceptable in Europe, but at the same time, it has become taboo to criticize Islam—even as Islamic terrorism menaces Europe. Here in America, according to a 2012 FBI report, there were 1,310 religiously motivated incidences reported in 2011; 62.2% were targeted against Jewish people, while 13.3% were anti-Islam motivated. (From Jewish Voice Today, March/April 2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God that you may declare the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His wonderful light.* 1Peter 2:9

Repent: When the church does not shine as a chosen, royal, holy people of God to the world.

Intercede: That the church's light will shine so brightly in this dark hour, and that many will be drawn to it and be saved.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He has called us out of the darkness and into His marvelous light.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO WALK IN
THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT
THURSDAY, AUGUST 29, 2013
DAY 24**

*But you will receive **power** when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.* Acts 1:8

And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you. Romans 8:11

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Ephesians 3:20-21

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Romans 8:11

Do I believe and live a life that demonstrates that the power that raised Christ from the dead lives in *me*?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: **Thank our Father** for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For yourself and family members where your lives do not reflect the power of the Holy Spirit.

Intercede: That you will allow the power that raised Christ from the dead to work through you.

NATION: *But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive... ..having a form of godliness but denying its power.* 2Tim 3:1-2, 5

Repent: For our culture which reflects the characteristics of 2Tim 3.

Intercede: That our culture will turn from its wicked ways and repent before greater judgment falls.

ISRAEL: *You were shown these things so that you might know that the Lord is God; besides Him there is no other. Because He loved your forefathers and chose their descendants after them, He brought you out of Egypt by His presence and His great power.* Deuteronomy 4:35,37

Thank our Father for the awesome display of His power when He delivered His people out of Egypt.

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people who do not call on the Spirit's power to deliver them from the danger that surrounds them.

Intercede: That believers in Israel would live lives that are demonstrations of the Spirit's power and would draw Israelis to their Messiah.

Anti-Semitism: The United Nations Human Rights Council recently conducted a six-month investigation that resulted in accusations that Israel "committed multiple violations of International law...possibly including war crimes." (From B'Nai Brith International)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.* 1 Cor 2:4-5

Thank our Father for ppastors that operate in the power of the Holy Spirit.

Repent: For denominations that resist the power of the Holy Spirit

Intercede: For church leaders, pastors and teachers to live lives that demonstrate the power of the Holy Spirit.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He has given us resurrection power. May we all allow that power to be demonstrated in and through our lives.

REPENT FOR MY UNREPENTANT HEART
FRIDAY, AUGUST 30, 2013
DAY 25

Repent, then, and turn to God, so that our sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord, and that He may send the Christ, who has been appointed for you—even Jesus. Acts 3:19-20

Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death. 2Cor 7:10

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For any and all unrepentant sin in your life or lives of family members.

Intercede: Allow the conviction of the Holy Spirit to move your hearts to godly sorrow that leads to repentance.

NATION: *“Even now,” declares the Lord, “return to Me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning.” Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love and He relents from sending calamity.*

Joel 2:12-13

Repent: That the heart of our nation is unrepentant and hard as stone to God.

The time has come, the Kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news! Mark 1:15

Intercede: That our nation will turn from its wicked ways and return to God with fasting and weeping and mourning.

ISRAEL: *Ever since the time of your forefathers you have turned away from my decrees and have not kept them. Return to me and I will return to you, says the Lord Almighty.* Malachi 3:7

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people that they try to earn their righteousness through works and not through faith in the One who makes them righteous.

I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the Lord. They will be my people and I will be their God, for they will return to Me with all their heart. Jer 24:7

Intercede: In agreement with Jeremiah 24:7 that the Jewish people will return to the Holy One of Israel with all their hearts.

Anti-Semitism: The United Nations is only one forum where Israel's rights as a nation are being denied. The leaders of several U.S. *church groups* recently urged our government to withhold military funding to Israel—their apparent complaint being that Israel uses the aid to defend herself. (From B'Nai Brith Int.)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism which for centuries has operated in the church and through Christians, fostering great pain and suffering to the Jewish people and culminating with the Holocaust.

CHURCH: *I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth.* Rev 3:15-16

Repent: For the lukewarm state of the church today.

Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; obey it and repent. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you. Rev 3:3

Intercede: That the church will wake up, repent and make herself ready for her Bridegroom.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that when we return to You, You return to us with your arms wide open to receive us back to You.

Intercede: For Israel's "fullness" which will mean even greater riches for the world.

Anti-Semitism: Anti-Semitism continues today in a new sophisticated form called anti-Zionism. Whereas anti-Semitism sought to drive out the Jews from the lands where they lived, anti-Zionism refuses to accept their right to live in their own land. (From shema.com, Replacement Theology-Anti-Semitism: Its Roots and Perseverance)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *The former preach Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely, supposing that they can stir up trouble for me while I am in chains. Phil 1:17*

Repent: For churches that operate out of selfish ambition and self-glorification. *To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Col 1:27*

Intercede: For believers to passionately proclaim "Christ in me, the hope of glory!"

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love toward us.

REPENT FOR DIVISION/DIVISIVENESS

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2013

DAY 27

Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name—the name you gave Me—so that they may be one as we are one. John 17:11b

I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought. 1Corinthians 1:10

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read John 17:20-23

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 1Cor 1:10

Do I strive for unity with my brothers and sisters in Christ?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style.

Repent: For ourselves and our family members, for the times we carry a divisive spirit.

ISRAEL: Remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who were once

far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ . For He Himself is our peace, who has made the two one, and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility. Ephesians 2:12-14

Repent: For taking what was given to Israel and not appreciating that without Israel, Gentiles would be without hope.

His purpose was to create in Himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace, and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross by which He put to death their hostility. Ephesians 2:15b-16

Intercede: For the “one new man” reality to come to pass.

Anti-Semitism: A 2002 document was issued by Dr. James Kennedy’s Knox Theological Seminary. It took the form of an open letter to Evangelicals concerning the land of Israel. It has since been endorsed by hundreds of pastors and theologians. It states in part that the promises made to Abraham “do not apply to any particular ethnic group, but to the church of Jesus Christ, the true Israel”. The document denies the Jews’ claim on any land in the Middle East. (From shema.com, Replacement Theology-Anti-Semitism: Its Roots and Persevrance)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism which for centuries has operated in the church and through Christians, fostering great pain and suffering to the Jewish people and culminating with the Holocaust.

CHURCH: *May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent Me and have loved them even as you have loved Me.* John 17:23b

Repent: For the divisions and divisiveness among the denominations within the body of Christ which completely contradict Jesus’ prayer in John 17:23.

Intercede: That a spirit of unity will overtake the church in a powerful way in this hour.

PRAISE/THANK our Father for the perfect unity among the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

**REPENT FOR THE SPIRIT OF FEAR
THAT QUENCHES THE HOLY SPIRIT
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2013
DAY 28**

For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of Sonship. And by Him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. Rom 8:15-16

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read John 6:25-34

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Romans 8:15-16

In what do I find my identity? Do I find my identity in being a child of God?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you.

(From the ADL (Anti-Defamation League), 5/29/13)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *But make up your mind not to worry beforehand how you will defend yourselves. For I will give you words and wisdom that none of our adversaries will be able to resist or contradict. You will be betrayed even by parents, brothers, relatives and friends, and they will put some of you to death. All men will hate you because of me. But not a hair of your head will perish. By standing firm you will gain life.* Luke 21:14-19

Repent: For fear and worry about the persecution that is to come.

Intercede: That the church will rise up and stand as a powerful light and witness to the world in the midst of persecution and turmoil.

The document concludes with the following observation: "The present secular state of Israel...is not an authentic or prophetic realization of the Messianic kingdom of Jesus Christ." (From shema.com)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism which for centuries has operated in the church and through Christians, fostering great pain and suffering to the Jewish people and culminating with the Holocaust.

CHURCH: *Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.* John 17:17

Repent: That segments of the church reject scriptural inerrancy and do not honor the whole truth of God's word, but instead, pick and choose which truths to accept and live by.

Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Intercede: That our nation will repent and turn back to God’s truth before judgment falls.

ISRAEL: Thank our Father for watchmen on the wall giving Him no rest until He establishes and makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth.

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism which for centuries has operated in the church and through Christians, fostering great pain and suffering to the Jewish people and culminating with the Holocaust.

CHURCH: *Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshippers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshippers the Father seeks. God is spirit and His worshippers must worship in spirit and in truth.* John 4:23-24

Repent: We grieve the Spirit when we don’t worship the Father in spirit and truth.

Intercede: That the body of Christ will come into the fullness of the Spirit of truth that has been given to us and lives in us.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He has not left us helpless but has given us His Spirit to guide us in all truth.

REPENT FOR FAILURE TO BE CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2013

DAY 34

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me. Gal 2:20

For we know that our old self was crucified with Him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin—because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. Romans 6:6-7

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Romans 6:1-7

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Gal 2:20 & Rom 6:6-7

My old self was crucified with Christ so that I am no longer a slave to sin—because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. Does my life reflect this reality?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family member whenever we are unwilling to deny ourselves, pick up our crosses and follow Christ (Luke 9:23)

Intercede: For a full revelation that the world has been crucified to me and I to the world. (Gal 6:14)

NATION: *Therefore God gave them over in the sinful desires of their hearts to sexual impurity for the degrading of their bodies with one another. They*

exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshipped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised. Amen. Romans 1:24-25

Repent: For the sinful desires of hedonism, perversion and selfishness that are growing exponentially in our culture.

Intercede: That Almighty God would have mercy on us.

ISRAEL: Repent: In Israel, as in our culture, the sinful desires of hedonism, perversion and selfishness are growing exponentially. As we repent for our nation, let us also repent on behalf of Israel.

Since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God. 2Cor 7:1

Intercede: That Israel would turn back to her God in reverence and return to her true identity as a nation called, chosen and set apart.

Anti-Semitism: Like every sovereign nation, Israel has an inherent right to defend its citizens from terrorist attacks and threats to its existence. Israel has faced an unprecedented wave of suicide and rocket attacks during the past decade. Despite these dangers, the Israel Defense Forces go beyond any fighting force in the world to avoid civilian casualties. But even with this, the UN has frequently and disproportionately singled out Israel for exercising its basic right of self-defense. (from AIPAC)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Repent: For sin that grieves the Spirit and exists at all levels in the church..

Intercede: For the revelation to fall on the church that when we were baptized into Christ, we were baptized into His death and buried with Him through baptism into death in order that we may live as new creations in Christ.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that to live is Christ and to die is gain (Phl 1:21)

REPENT FOR PRIDE WHICH GRIEVES THE HOLY SPIRIT
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2013
DAY 35

The Lord detests all the proud of heart. Be sure of this: They will not go unpunished. Proverbs 16:5

A man's pride brings him low, but a man of lowly spirit gains honor. Prov 29:23

The brother in humble circumstances ought to take pride in his high position. But the one who is rich should take pride in his low position, because he will pass away like a wild flower. James 1:9-10

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Isaiah 2:12-18

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Proverbs 16:5, Proverbs 29:23 and James 1:9-10

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal all areas of your life where the sin of pride exists.
Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For yourself and family members for prideful attitudes toward God and man.

Intercede: For willing and repentant hearts so that our lowly spirits will gain us honor.

NATION: Thank our Father for abundantly blessing our nation.

By your great skill in trading you have increased your wealth, and because of your wealth your heart has grown proud. Ezekiel 28:5

Repent: That our culture has grown proud and arrogant, forgetting that our talents and blessings come from God.

Intercede: That our culture would repent and acknowledge the source of all our blessings.

ISRAEL: *But Hezekiah's heart was proud and he did not respond to the kindness shown him; therefore the Lord's wrath was on him and on Judah and Jerusalem.* 2 Chronicles 32:25

Repent: For any pride or arrogance within Israel's leadership.

Then Hezekiah repented of the pride of his heart, as did the people of Jerusalem; therefore the Lord's wrath did not come upon them during the days of Hezekiah.

2 Chronicles 32:26

Intercede: That the Israeli people and their leaders will repent of pride so that the Lord's wrath will not come upon them.

Anti-Semitism: Several years ago, five of the top ten best selling books in Japan were virulently anti-Semitic, blaming all the problems of Japan on an "international Jewish conspiracy." (From shema.com, Replacement Theology—Anti-Semitism: Its Roots and Perseverance.)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.*

Proverbs 16:18

Repent: For pride and arrogance that exists in church leadership among all denominations.

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited. Romans 12:16

Intercede: That the church denominations will lay down the sin of pride and live in harmony with one another and focus on the centrality of Christ.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that the Messiah came as a humble servant who did not consider equality with the Father something to be grasped.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO RECEIVE
THE COUNSEL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2013
DAY 36**

If you love Me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever—the Spirit of truth.

John 14:15-17a

All this I have spoken while still with you. But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. John 14:25-26

Teach me to do your will, for you are my God, may your good Spirit lead me on level ground. Psalm 143:10

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read John 14:25-31

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read John 14:15-17a, John 14:25-26, & Psalm 143:10

FAMILIES: **Thank our Father** for our families.

Intercede: For a hunger and openness to receive the full counsel of the Holy Spirit.

NATION: *When there is no guidance, a nation falls, but there is success in the abundance of counselors.* Proverbs 11:14

Repent: That our nation has fallen so far from our Father, His Son and the counsel of His Holy Spirit.

Intercede: For a mighty move of the Holy Spirit to sweep over our nation and fill our leaders with the wisdom, truth and counsel of the Holy Spirit.

ISRAEL: Thank our Father that He gave the Wonderful Counselor to the world.

For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people who have rejected the Son of David, the Wonderful Counselor.

Intercede: That the Jewish people will see that the Son of David they await has already come once in the flesh and will soon return to them.

Anti-Semitism: Our nation's administration has unblocked \$500 million in funding for the ferociously anti-Israel Palestinian Authority, whose government (controlled by Hamas) is sworn to destroy the Jewish people. (From ACLJ, June 2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: Thank our Father that He empowers His body by His Holy Spirit *A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him—the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord—and He will delight in the fear of the Lord. Isa 11:1-3*

Repent: When the church grieves the Spirit by not walking in His counsel.

Intercede: That the church will walk in the fullness of the seven Spirits of God.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He has sent us the Holy Spirit, the Counselor, to be with us forever and to teach us all things.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO ACKNOWLEDGE
THE SPIRIT INTERCEDES FOR ME
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2013
DAY 37**

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And He who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will.

Romans 8:26-27

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Romans 8:18-27

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Rom 8:26-27

Am I strengthened in the knowledge that the Holy Spirit is interceding for me in my weakness?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family members for not acknowledging the powerful role of the Holy Spirit as our intercessor.

Intercede: That we would always walk in the confidence of knowing that the Holy Spirit is interceding for us.

NATION: Thank our Father for those leaders who are praying without ceasing for our nation.

Repent: For those leaders and lawmakers who continuously attempt to remove prayer from more and more venues in our nation.

Intercede: That the voice of the vocal minority that wishes to remove prayer from our nation will be silenced.

ISRAEL: *What other nation is so great as to have their gods near them the way the Lord our God is near us whenever we pray to Him? Deut 4:7*

Repent: That we do not make prayer and intercession for Israel a top priority.

Intercede: That Israel will once again become a nation that prays to her God, and turns to her God for strength.

Anti-Semitism: The U.S. is arming Israel's enemies, supplying weapons to hostile next-door neighbor, Egypt. U.S. supplied F-16s, controlled by Islamic extremists, will be seven minutes away from Jerusalem.

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *Be joyful always, **pray continually**, give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1Thess 5:16-18*

Repent: For churches that do not make prayer a top priority and function of their body.

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

James 5:16

Intercede: That a powerful praying **church** will lead our **nation** back to prayer.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that His Holy Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with the will of God.

REPENT FOR BITTERNESS AND UNFORGIVENESS
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2013
DAY 38

For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins. Matthew 6:14-15

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Eph 4:30-31

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Colossians 3:12-17

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read Matt 6:14-15 & Ephesians 4:30-31

Where do I have bitterness and unforgiveness in my heart?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: Thank our Father for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family members when we hold onto bitterness and unforgiveness because we feel justified.

Intercede: For a godly sorrow which leads us to repent of any and all bitterness and unforgiveness.

NATION: *Perhaps when the people of Judah hear about every disaster I plan to inflict on them, each of them will turn from his wicked way; then I will forgive their wickedness and their sin. Jeremiah 36:3*

Repent: For the sin and wickedness that has overtaken our nation.

I will cleanse them from all the sin they have committed against me and will forgive all their sins of rebellion against me. Jeremiah 33:8

Intercede: For a move of repentance to overcome our nation, and that we turn from our wickedness and rebellion, so that the Lord will forgive our sins.

ISRAEL: Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God. Your sins have been your downfall! Take words with you and return to the Lord. Say to Him: “Forgive all our sins and receive us graciously that we may offer the fruit of our lips.”

Hosea 14:1-2

Repent: On behalf of the Jewish people that they would repent and return to the Holy One of Israel.

The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against Him. O, Lord, in keeping with all your righteous acts, turn away your anger and your wrath from Jerusalem, your city, your holy hill. Dan 9:9, 16a

Intercede: That the Holy One of Israel, who is forgiving and rich in mercy, will forgive Israel for all her sin.

Anti-Semitism: An outrageous new art exhibit which refers to Israel as a “colonial power” and Palestinian terrorists as “fighters” has opened in a museum in Paris, which is subsidized by the French government. Suicide bombers are referred to as “militants who heroically set out to assassinate Israelis.” (From Simon Ploster, HonestReporting, 6/9/13)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH:

Repent: For when the church does not reflect love and forgiveness to the world.

Intercede: For the church to become a beacon of light that will draw the lost and hopeless to the love of Christ.

PRAISE/THANK our Father that He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin.

**REPENT FOR FAILURE TO ACKNOWLEDGE
THE JUDGMENT TO COME
FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2013
DAY 39**

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive what is due him, for the things done while in the body, whether good or bad. 2Cor 5:10

Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people. He said in a loud voice, “Fear God and give Him glory because the hour of His judgment has come. Worship Him who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and the springs of water.” Revelation 14:6-7

OPENING PRAYER

CORPORATE READING: Read Psalm 51

WORSHIP: Musical Selections

PERSONAL REFLECTION/REPENTANCE: Read 2Cor 5:10 & Revelation 14:6-7

Do I live and act with a keen awareness of the judgment to come?

Period of silent prayer/repentance as you allow the Spirit to minister to you

FAMILIES: **Thank our Father** for our families.

Pray: Spiritual/physical/financial needs of family. Silent or Korean style

Repent: For ourselves and family members when we live our lives without a fear or acknowledgment that we will stand before our righteous Judge.

Intercede: For the Holy Spirit conviction of the judgment to come to fall upon us.

NATION: *Say among the nations, “The Lord reigns.” The world is firmly established, it cannot be moved; He will judge the peoples with equity. Ps 97:10*

Repent: Our nation does not fear judgment.

Intercede: That our merciful and righteous Judge will judge all peoples with equity.

ISRAEL: *Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love. Remember the height from which you have fallen! Repent and do the things you did at first.* Revelation 2:4-5a

Repent: For how we have forsaken Israel, our Father's first love.

Intercede: That the Father would deposit into our hearts the love He has for His firstborn, Israel.

Anti-Semitism: Our nation's leader is calling for Jerusalem to be divided, for Israel's land to be handed over to terrorists, for Israel's borders to be so shriveled as to be literally indefensible—only nine miles wide at one point. (From ACLJ, 6/2013)

Corporate Repentance: We abhor, denounce and repent for the deadly sin of Anti-Semitism.

CHURCH: *But I tell you that men will have to give account on the Day of Judgment for every careless word they have spoken. For by your words you will be acquitted and by your words you will be condemned.* Matthew 12:36-37

Repent: For how rarely the 2nd coming and judgment of Christ is preached from the pulpit to prepare the people for what is coming.

Intercede: That Holy Spirit conviction will fall on pastors and teachers to sound the alarm and prepare the people for the judgment to come.

PRAISE/THANK our Father for He comes to judge the world in righteousness and the peoples in His truth (Psalm 97:13)
